2025 ENGAGEMENT OPPORTUNITIES:

Michigan EIBC members can opt-in to add-on initiatives and regulatory opportunities to deepen their engagement and impact. Small business discounts are available!

- **Regulatory sub-committee** (\$2,000 per year): Deep-dive into all ongoing regulatory activities including state wind/solar/storage siting issues.
- **Energy storage** (\$2,500 per year): Shape advocacy to implement the state's energy storage mandate, improve IRP modeling processes, establish fair taxation for storage, and enable virtual power plants.
- **Residential building decarbonization** (\$2,500 per year): Expand the energy efficiency and home electrification markets by providing key input and feedback to develop a residential building decarbonization roadmap for Michigan.
- **Solar for All** (\$2,500 per year): Provide input and gain information about Michigan's implementation of its \$156 million MI Solar for All program with monthly initiative meetings, including bi-monthly meetings with representatives from EGLE's Solar for All team.
- **Transportation electrification** (\$2,500 per year): Shape advocacy to implement the recommendations from the Transportation Electrification Policy Roadmap, receive information and provide input on critical pieces of legislation, and engage with key state decision makers.
